Commercial

Changes effective June 1, 2022 Surgery

- Left-Atrial Appendage Closure Devices for Stroke Prevention in Atrial Fibrillation (#SUR195)
 - Added coverage for the Amplatzer Amulet device when policy criteria are met

Changes effective July 1, 2022 Genetic Testing

- Noninvasive Prenatal Testing to Determine Fetal Aneuploidies and Microdeletions using Cell-Free DNA (#GT44)
 - Updated policy to consider sex chromosome aneuploidy testing medically necessary for member contracts subject to Washington's State Board of Health Rule (WAC 246-680)

Laboratory

- Drug Testing for Substance Use and Pain Management (#LAB68)
 - Added Q3 2022 quarterly code update regarding CPT 0328U to the criteria as not medically necessary

Medicine

- New and Emerging Medical Technologies and Procedures (#MED149)
 - Updated the policy to align with the Q3 2022 quarterly code update that addresses new investigational medical technologies, represented by CPT 0714T-0716T, 0723T-0729T, 0731T and 0732T and HCPCS G0308, G0309
 - Removed the following codes because they are being added to the following medical policies:
 - CPT 0621T, 0622; Laser Trabeculotomy and Trabeculostomy (#SUR227)
 - CPT 0664T, 0665T, 0666T, 0667T, 0668T, 0669T, 0670T; Uterus Transplant (#TRA19)
 - HCPCS C9781; Subacromial Balloon Placement (#SUR226)

Surgery

- Rhinoplasty (#SUR12.28)
 - Revised policy criteria to clarify the policy applies to initial or revision rhinoplasty
 - Removed the requirement for photographs demonstrating obstruction; advanced imaging continues to be required to demonstrate bony obstruction
- Laser Trabeculotomy and Trabeculostomy (#SUR227)
 - New medical policy considers excimer laser trabeculostomy/ trabeculotomy (ELT) and femtosecond laser trabeculotomy (FLT) to be investigational
- Subacromial Balloon Placement (#SUR226)
 - New medical policy considers the use of subacromial balloon spacers to be investigational

Transplant

- Uterus Transplant (#TRA19)
 - New medical policy considers uterus transplantation to be investigational

Changes effective October 1, 2022 Surgery

- Leadless Cardiac Pacemakers (#SUR217)
 - o Adding Aveir system as investigational
- Ventral (Including Incisional) Hernia Repair (#SUR12.03)
 - Revising medical policy title; policy was previously called Ventral Hernia Repair
 - Adding definition regarding hernia-associated pain and documentation requirements

- Updating policy guidelines regarding component separation technique
- Updating throughout to clarify the policy applies to incisional ventral hernias

Medicare Advantage

Changes effective July 1, 2022 Durable Medical Equipment

- External Insulin Infusion Pumps (#M-DME86)
 - Removed HCPCS A4238 from the policy and pre-authorization list

Medicine

- Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT) (#M-MED136)
 - Revised language in the Required Documentation section for clarification: "comparative 3D versus IMRT dose/volume histograms in color AND a completed summary analysis (table preferred; with preauthorization request)"

Radiology

- Magnetic Resonance Spectroscopy (#M-RAD27)
 - New Medicare Advantage medical policy

Surgery

- Laser Trabeculotomy and Trabeculostomy (#M-SUR227)
 - New Medicare Advantage medical policy
- Subacromial Balloon Placement (#M-SUR226)
 - New Medicare Advantage medical policy

Transplant

- Uterus Transplant (#M-TRA19)
 - New Medicare Advantage medical policy

Providing up-to-date and accurate information about the providers in each of our networks is critical for our members to access care and a compliance requirement for the Affordable Care Act (ACA) and Medicare Advantage plans.

Validating provider directory content

Please <u>follow these steps</u> to review the information about your practice every 90 days. Please respond timely to any requests from us for verification of your directory data.

If your clinic or facility submits provider rosters to us, please submit changes, corrections, additions or terminations immediately so we can update our directories as soon as possible. Your roster must be validated and reviewed in its entirety at least once per quarter.
